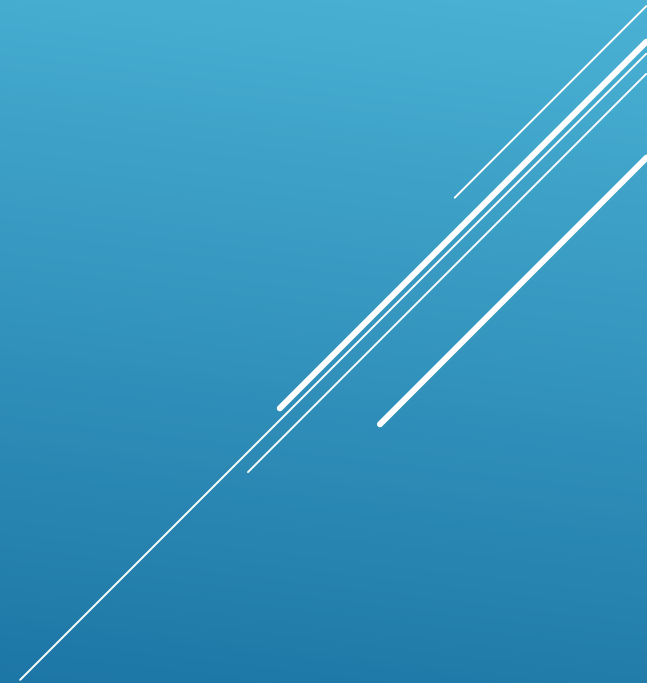

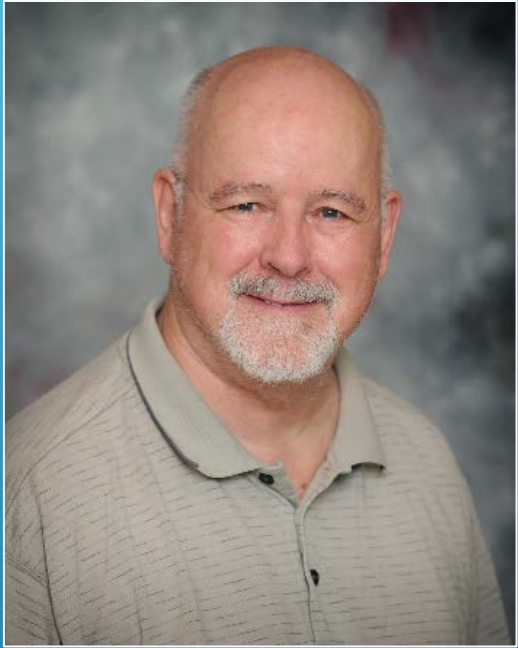

## ▶ Dr. David Wells

- ▶ PhD in Geodesy from University of New Brunswick
- ▶ Instrumental in preparing “Guide to GPS Positioning”
- ▶ Helped create the UNB Ocean Mapping Group
- ▶ Served on the faculties of UNB, UNH and USM
- ▶ Over 250 technical papers on precise positioning, marine positioning and marine mapping.
- ▶ Helped train a generation of hydrographers.
